Myrtle Beach Greek Festival ~ Vendor Contract

Thank you for your interest in a booth for the 2010 Myrtle Beach Greek Festival. This 19th annual fundraiser for St. John's Greek Orthodox Church promises to be even bigger than last year's.

Your booth will certainly add to the spirit of family atmosphere that our parishioners try to provide for the Grand Strand community.

Enclosed is your application. Please fill out and return it immediately. Space availability is dependent upon the number of entrants. Booths are assigned in the order that the applications are received, with preference given to last year's participants. We have indoor spaces available for \$600 for the entire event, and outdoor spaces available for \$300 for the total event.

Greek Festival Rules & Regulations:

1. *Financial agreement is ____% of gross sales (in addition to booth fee) contributed to St. John's Greek Orthodox Church for a 10' x 10' space.
2. All booths are provided with 110v electrical outlets.
3. Each vendor is responsible for providing tables, chairs, tent, lighting, etc.
4. Booths are to be decorated in a simple and attractive manner. Remember, if you choose an outdoor space, we recommend that you provide adequate shade and lighting.
5. All items to be sold must be approved by the Festival Committee in advance.
6. Set-up times are Wednesday, Sept. 22 from 1 – 6PM, and Thursday, Sept. 23 from 8:00 – 10:30AM. ***The Festival starts at 11:00 AM!***
7. Security is provided from Wednesday at 6:00PM until Sunday at 8:00AM to help protect your inventory. However, St. John's is not liable for any theft or damage that may occur.
8. Festival hours are Thursday, 11:00AM – 9:00PM; Friday and Saturday, 11:00AM – 10:00PM; and on Sunday from 11:00AM – 7:00PM, and booths are expected to be open the entire time. ***No one is to break down their booth until after 7:00PM on Sunday.***
9. Parking is allowed in the designated vendor area only – one vehicle per vendor.
10. NO PETS are allowed.
11. No children are to be left unattended.
12. Only two (2) vendor passes are allowed per booth.
